Basketball Saskatchewan Inc. (BSI) is the provincial sport governing body for amateur basketball in the province. We are currently seeking to hire a head coach for our 15U Women's Provincial Team Program and a head coach for the 15U Men's Provincial Team Program for the 2024 season. These part time positions will require some work to be completed in Jan-March with a focus on planning the season and player scouting, but the majority of the contract will take place late May to Mid August when the training and competition program begins.

Key Responsibilities

Work in Conjunction with BSI High Performance Staff to Create a Training and Competition Schedule/Program
Select qualified assistant coaches in partnership with Coaching Committee
Represent BSI at High School Provincial Championships.
Evaluate each athlete participating in tryouts and make final selection of team
Plan, supervise, direct, and evaluate all training sessions. The expectation will be that the program runs with a minimum of 40 hours of on court practice time.
Coach all tournaments on summer schedule, including National Championships. There is an average of 3 travel events leading up to National Championships.
Ensure appropriate behavior for team members at all competitions and training events
Track progress of athletes and communicate regularly to the BSI Staff.
Prepare final team report.
