2024 Provincial Team Format Background

The 2024 Provincial Team Program will be offering 17U and 15U Men's and Women's categories. Each category will select 22 players during the tryout process held in the spring of 2024. In each category 12 of the selected players will be considered the Senior Roster that will attend National Championships, the remaining 10 players will be part of our Development Rosters.

Players on the Senior and Development rosters will have the majority of their practices together throughout the summer which will be led by the programs head coach, but during the prep tournaments the players will split into their smaller rosters and participate separately in the tournaments.

Each program will offer 40 hours of court training time throughout the summer months, game experience at a minimum of 2 (and maximum of 4) prep competitions, with the Senior rosters also attending National Championships.

Coaching Positions Available

Each of the 4 programs (15U/17U Mens and Womens) will have 3 assistant coaching positions available, a lead assistant, a 2nd assistant and an apprentice assistant position. All positions will work under the leadership of their programs High Performance Head Coach in order to ensure a consistent development model for the players.

The lead and 2nd assistant coaches will receive opportunities to step into head coaching roles with the development rosters in their programs over the training program so that they continue to development their individual coaching skillset as well. The lead and 2nd assistant coach will be attending National Championships with the Senior roster in their program.

The apprentice assistant position is ideal for a coach who is interested in taking the next step in their coaching journey and would like to learn about working with a high-performance provincial program. They will get the opportunity to work with both the senior and development rosters during training sessions (both practices and prep tournaments) but will not be attending National Championships.

Requirements

To be completed and submitted before program commencement: Vulnerable Sector Background Check – All Coaches Respect In Sport – All Coaches NCCP – Safe Sport Online Course



To Be completed and submitted by July 20th 2024:

Canada Basketball has made a change to the NCCP qualifications for coaching staff at National Championships. Beginning in 2024 all coaches (regardless of which age group you are coaching in) will have to meet the below certification requirements*:

1st year at Nationals – NCCP Train to Compete/In Training. This is a minimum of 1 sport specific and 1 multisport course

2nd year at Nationals – NCCP Train to Compete/ Trained. This means you must have completed all of your courses

3rd year at Nationals – NCCP Train to Compete/ Certified. This means you have taken all of your courses and have also completed your evaluation process.

*Coaches who have been to Nationals at the 15U level previously would be considered 1st year coaches for certification requirements for 2024

Coaches will be expected to attend all tryout and training events unless there is an exceptional reason for an absence.

Important Dates on the Calendar SuperCamp (open tryouts) April 6th and 7th in Martensville PrairieCup Challenge Tournament June 29th and 30th in Brandon National Championships (including travel days) August 3rd-11th. Mens tournament is in the GTA, Womens tournament is in St. Johns Nfld.
