



Posting: Saskatchewan Summer Games Basketball Coaches

Term: 2024 Saskatchewan Summer Games Season (March-July)

Start Date: March 1st 2024

Basketball Saskatchewan Inc. (BSI) is the provincial sport governing body for amateur basketball in the province. We are currently seeking to select coaches for each of the 18 basketball teams that will be participating in the Saskatchewan Summer Games. (9 districts, 2 coaches per team, 1 male and 1 female team per district). These volunteer positions will require some work to be completed in March with a focus on planning the season, but the majority of the coaching will take place late May to July when the training and competition program runs.

Key Responsibilities

Work in Conjunction with BSI Staff and SaskSport District Staff to create a tryout and training schedule
Work with your coaching partner to determine specific roles/responsibilities while with the team
Evaluate each athlete participating in tryouts and make final selection of team
Plan, supervise, direct, and evaluate all training sessions. The expectation will be that the program runs with a minimum of 20 hours of on court practice time.
Teams will have the option to attend prep competitions if they choose. If your team does add a tournament to their schedule you will be responsible for the planning and coaching associated with it (with admin support if required from the BSI office staff).
Ensure all administrative components required for coaches and players to participate in the Sask Summer Games is completed fully and on time
Ensure appropriate behavior for team members at all competitions and training events
Attend all required events leading up to the Games (ie information nights from your district, send off rallies etc)
Attend the Sask Summer Games (basketball will be held July 24th-27th)

Qualifications

- NCCP Certification in Learn to Train. Consideration will also be given to those that are actively working on their pathways but have not yet completed the course (please note that the course is mandatory in order to be in attendance at Games, so if you have not yet taken it, you will need to have attended a course prior to July 5th 2024;
- NCCP Safe Sport Certification
