



Position Title: Technical Director

General Description

The Technical Director will be responsible to manage the creation, delivery and enhancement of Basketball Saskatchewan domestic programs and initiatives with primary responsibility in the areas of:

1. Coach Education and Development
2. Player Development
3. Administration and Communications

The position will also have a secondary responsibility to ensure the organizations High Performance Coaches are supported in their delivery of the Basketball Saskatchewan High Performance Strategic Plan.

Organizational Structure

The Technical Director reports to and takes direction from the Executive Director. The Technical Director will have a non voting position within the Players Development and Coaches Development committees.

Liaison

Power of Decision Making

The Technical Director has authority to take the measures that are necessary in the daily management of the Association approved plans, policies and programs. For actions required beyond these limits, the Technical Director is required to have decisions approved through the Executive Director.

Specific Responsibilities

- A. Administration and Communications
 - Submission of Project Plans
 - Provide monthly and annual report of activities
 - Work with office administrator to ensure areas of website relating to coach and player development programs are current and accurate
 - Attend AGM and organization committee meetings
 - Create and manage the technical portion of the Club Membership Package
 - Serve as a BSI representative at various events around the province

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B. Coach Education and Development

- Complete all levels of NCCP certification
- Complete NCCP Learning Facilitator certification
- Complete NCCP Evaluator certification
- Delivery of NCCP courses as needed
- Identification and development of NCCP facilitators and evaluators
- Creation and delivery of a coaching clinic program that will supplement NCCP courses
- Identification and development of supplemental program facilitators
- Creation and delivery of a coach mentorship program
- Coach identification and recruitment for various BSI programs
- Creation of online content library

C. Player Development

- Create a standardization of content for the BSI Futures Program (players age 8-14)
- Create a standardization of content for Players Clinic Program (players age 15-18)
- Delivery of player clinics each year, quantity of which will be predetermined by the Executive Director
- Creation of online content library

D. High Performance Program

- Regular meetings with High Performance Coaching group to ensure HP Plan is being delivered and any issues or areas of concern are being addressed
- Participate in program conclusion debriefs
- Attend at least 1 of the National Championships each year where various duties will include mentorship responsibilities, video and scout reports and program chef de mission
